OR

Met the requirements and enrolled into a 2 year Community College, Technical or Trade School.

TWO-YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE, TECHNICAL OR TRADE SCHOOL

Eligibility

The UFCW Local 700 Scholarship Fund is pleased to provide scholarships for students pursuing postsecondary education at a two-year community college, technical or trade school. This scholarship is intended for those with financial need who meet the eligibility requirements.

TRADITIONAL STUDENTS

To be eligible for the scholarship as a traditional student attending a two-year community college, technical or trade school, you <u>must</u>:

- Have a 2.75 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) or higher in high school.
- Be a high school senior who will graduate at the end of the current academic year, 2015.

NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENTS

To be eligible for the scholarship as a non-traditional student attending a two-year community college, technical or trade school, you <u>must</u>:

• Have been out of high school at least two years. (If you have earned a GED, you <u>may</u> have done so within the past two years, however, you still must have been out of high school for at least two years.)

ALL APPLICANTS

In addition to the above requirements, all applicants must:

- Have completed the application/admission process at an accredited institution of higher learning, i.e. two-year community college, technical or trade school, be currently enrolled, or be registered or applied for admission for the Spring semester.
- Complete the entire scholarship, including an essay, and supplying supporting materials as listed.
- Mail your completed application, postmarked by August 7, 2015.

Selection Criteria

Traditional student recipients will be competitively selected based on:

- Academic Record
- Transcript Evaluation = 25%
- Essay = 40%
- Employment and public service = 35%

Non-Traditional student recipients will be competitively selected based on:

- Essay = 40%
- Employment and public service = 60%

The scholarship's board of directors intends to award a number of traditional student scholarships and non-traditional student scholarships in the two-year category this selection cycle. However, the board retains the right to award additional scholarships or adjust award amounts at its sole discretion. This scholarship is non-renewable.

Application Procedure

To apply for the scholarship, submit the application and supply supporting materials as listed in the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
