SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A total of \$11,000 in scholarships will be awarded to UFCW Local 700 members or their dependents who have graduated or will graduate from high school, or are currently enrolled in college or trade school. Awards are as follows: Five @ \$1,000 – Twelve @ \$500.

Applicants must UFCW Local 700 members in good standing, or their legal dependents; must have completed the SAT or ACT, and be accepted to an accredited institution OR met the requirements and enrolled in a two-year community college, technical, or trade school.

FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY

UFCW Local 700 Scholarship Fund proudly awards scholarships to students pursuing postsecondary education at a two-year community college, technical, or trade school. Scholarships are intended for applicants with financial need who meet eligibility requirements.

TRADITIONAL STUDENTS

To be eligible for a scholarship as a traditional student attending a two-year community college, technical, or trade school, applicants must:

- Earn a high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.75, or higher, on a 4.0 scale
- Be a high school senior graduating at the end of the current academic year (2017)

NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENTS

To be eligible for a scholarship as a non-traditional student attending a two-year community college, technical, or trade school, applicants must have been out of high school for at least two years. If an applicant earned a GED, may have done so within the past two years, but still must have graduated from high school at least two years ago.

ALL APPLICANTS

In addition to the requirements above, all applicants must have:

- Completed the application/admission process at an accredited institution of higher learning, such as a two-year college, technical, or trade school; or must be currently enrolled, registered, or have applied for admission for the spring semester
- Submitted the entire scholarship application packet, including essay and any required supporting materials
- Mailed your completed application to the address below with a postmark no later than August 11, 2017

SELECTION CRITERION

Traditional students will be competitively selected based upon:

- Academic record
- Essay (40%)
- Transcript evaluation (25%)
- Employment and Public Service (20%)
- SAT or ACT Score (15%)

Non-Traditional students will be competitively selected based upon:

- Essay (40%)
- Employment and Public Service (60%)

The scholarship's Board of Directors intends to award a number of traditional student scholarships and non-traditional student scholarships in the two-year category this selection cycle. However, the Board retains the right to award additional scholarships or adjust award amounts at its sole discretion. This scholarship is not renewable.
